RACE1 0-64 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, EMPEROR OF THE SUN (T Gillett) was a little slow into stride whilst KANGXI (C Moon) and BRITISH BULLDOG (P Denton) made contact.

WORK THE BODY (C Lloyd) raced wide rounding the home turn.

RANDI (W Davis) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn and down the length of the straight.

Stewards questioned T Gillett (EMPEROR OF THE SUN) as to its disappointing performance in this event.

T Gillett advised that after being slow out of the barriers, his mount was reluctant to stretch out once receiving the kick back from other runners.

1ST CONCINI 2ND BRITISH BULLDOG 3RD PASSADANE

RACE 2 0-70 HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, NOIR RESOIR (R Vigar) jumped awkwardly bumping PLANET KING (K Connor).

MIDNIGHT GIGGLE (T Gillett) raced wide throughout the event.

1st SO REAL 2ND KEL OF A SHOT 3RD ONTHEHUSSLE

RACE 3 CLASS B HANDICAP 1100 METRE:

VOLATILE ROSE was a late scratching from this event at 5:05 by order of the Stewards after its rider T Gillett was found to be excessively overweight and no other replacement rider was on course.

As no bets had been taken on this event, there were no deductions were applicable. T Gillett was found guilty of a charge under AR120(b) in that he accepted the ride on VOLATILE ROSE for which he was found to be over-weight and was fined the sum of \$200 and notified of his right of appeal.

Apprentice R Vigar, in the company of his master Mrs L Lefoe appeared before the Stewards regarding his riding of GO CARNARGIE in the early stages of the event. He had been instructed to take up a forward position but after his mount was slow to begin he had attempted unsuccessfully to ride vigorously to muster speed. Stewards expressed concern with his wayward riding style when attempting to do this and in their opinion his efforts were detrimental to keeping his mount balanced through this section of the race. Apprentice R Vigar was provided with tutelage in regards to this incident and advised to take steps to ensure that he does not ride in this manner in future.

1ST NEXT IN LINE 2ND UNCOVERED WEALTH 3RD KEEP THE CROWN

RACE 4 0-58 HANDICAP 1000 METRES:

As the gates opened, JASWIN (T Gillett) was slow into stride whilst HONEY GREEN (P Crich) and JESTER SMILE (C Moon) made contact.

PRIVATE DOWNS (P Denton) raced wide throughout with no cover.

1ST PRIVATE DOWNS 2ND JESTER SMILE 3RD VODOO PRINCE

RACE 5 BENCHMARK 73 HANDICAP 1000M:

CATCH AS CATCH CAN (C Lloyd) and RIPLEYS (R Vigar) contacted at the start when both horses shifted ground.

Just passing the 900m, INVINCIBLE GOLD (C Moon) had to steady off the heels of LUCERNE VALE (T Gillett) which was rolling in slightly whilst racing forward.

T Gillett dropped his whip at the 200 metres.
