RACE 1 BENCHMARK 74 HANDICAP 1100 METRES: No report

1ST GAP EXPRESS: C JOHNSON

2ND BARSTOOL: C MOON

3RD KIRIKIRISH: K GLADWIN

RACE 2 0-58 HANDICAP 1100 METRES: As the gates opened, BERRIGAN BABY (B Carlile) was slow into stride.

About the 100 metre BERRIGAN BABY had to steady after shifting out off the fence around NORTHERN SHOWERS (M Evans) and bumping SKYCONI (C Moon) which inturn was shifting in making a run. MAKEATON (C Johnson) which was racing out wide began to shift in from about the 100 metre. Subsequent to this event, C Johnson rider of MAKEATON was reminded and advised that in similar circumstances in future he must stop riding and straighten his mounts.

RACE 3 TROBIS MAIDEN PLATE 1200 METRES: Approaching the 600 metre, NO TAX ON CASH (K Gladwin) had to steady after racing up on to the heels of RIVIERA ROYALE (D McIntosh).

1ST DISK JOCKEY: M EVANS

2ND CORPORAL JANE: M FITZGERALD (A)

3RD NO TAX ON CASH: K GLADWIN

RACE 4 0-63 HANDICAP 1200 METRES: As the gates opened ACADEMY KID (D McIntosh) was slow away and SINGLE COMMAND (B Carlile) jumped a little awkwardly.

Approaching the 600 metre SINGLE COMMAND had to steady slightly off the heels of front runners. MCKECHNIE(C Spry) shifted out at the 200 metre and brushed with MUSKETEER (C Johnson) on its outside.

TALAMAGNE (K Gladwin) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

V Oldfield trainer of MOON MISSION was fined \$50 under AR 140A for presenting his runner with the incorrect gear.

RACE 5 0-69 HANDICAP 1400 METRES: M Evans the rider of BLACKFORD was found guilty of a charge under AR137A (5)(i). The details being that prior to the 100 metre he used his whip in a forehand manner in consecutive strides.

Stewards ordered that M Evans forfeit his riding fee for BLACKFORD (AR196 (2)).
