RACE 1 3YO BENCHMARK 52 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, APPLE CIDER ALLEY (K Manoukian) was a little slow into stride. METRO (C Moon) was inclined to race ungenerously throughout the event. Subsequent to this event it was found that the saddle on METRO had slipped back at about the 500 metres.

RACE 2 0-64 HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

At about the 900 metre, LORD BANNER (C Ellis) which was racing forward on the outside crossed to the fence and as a result COUNTER CLAIM (B Hoppo) on its inside shifted in slightly causing MEGA MISS (J Cameron) to be momentarily tightened onto WORK THE BODY(K Manoukian).

Stewards advised C Ellis the rider of LORD BANNER that in similar circumstances she should allow her mounts to race along a little more when attempting to cross and ensure she was two lengths clear before shifting ground.

COUNTER CLAIM (B Hoppo) cast its near/side hind plate during the event.

RACE 3 CLASS B HANDICAP 1400 METRE:

RACE 4 0-58 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, BRITISH BULLDOG (J Cameron) and ROCKET BROTHER (C Moon) made contact.

Mrs L Lefoe was fined \$200 for presenting her runner BRITISH BULLDOG into the mounting yard with the incorrect gear (AR140A).

RACE 5 BENCHMARK 71 HANDICAP 1400 METRES:

As the gates opened, BOOM TRADER (K Gladwin) reared and lost some ground. TWICE BORN (M Evans) was inclined to over-race in the early stages of the event.

Ms K North trainer of BOOM TRADER was reminded of her obligations under AR.59A(1) after she failed to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for that gelding as was required by the stewards.

Subsequent to this event, stewards ordered a veterinary inspection of BOOM TRADER which performed poorly in this event.

As K North the trainer of BOOM TRADER had already left the course a veterinary inspection of the gelding was unable to be conducted.

Stewards adjourned an inquiry into Ms North leaving the course with BOOM TRADER within a half an hour of finishing the race without the consent of the stewards.

Whilst Ms North has subsequently advised the stewards that BOOM TRADER has now been retired due to an injury sustained during the event, stewards have advised that a Veterinary certificate of soundness would be required and the gelding would also need to undergo a satisfactory gallop of at least a 1000 metres in the presence of a steward if considering to enter the gelding to race again.
