#### **Race 1: Young Guns Day April 12<sup>th</sup> Class B Handicap 1200 metres**

**CALEJA** (C Moon) - Slow into stride

**SHOOT N SCOOT** (P Marks) – Slow into stride

**PINOT NOIR** (K Connor) – Raced wide throughout with no cover and inclined to lay out down the length of the straight.

**NEVER SATISFIED** (C Moon) –Despite the efforts of its rider failed to muster early speed.

#### **Race 2: Girls Day Out April 12<sup>th</sup> 0-76 Handicap 1200 metres**

**HOLLYWOOD AND VINE** (K Gladwin) – Raced wide rounding the home turn.

**MIDNIGHT GIGGLE** (C Moon) – Commenced awkwardly.

**HILLBILLY RICH** (P Marks) – Crowded at the start.

**SOPHISTICATED LASS** (B Huppertz) – Bumped on jumping.

**HOLLYWOOD HUSSLER** (W Davis) – Bumped on jumping and had difficulty maintaining a position in running. When questioned regarding the poor performance, rider advised that it was reluctant to stretch out properly being the first time on the dirt and was also inclined to lay out throughout the event. Trainer Mr J Peacock was advised that stewards will monitor the gelding at its next start. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

#### **Race 3: Family Fun Day April 19<sup>th</sup> 3YO Handicap 1100 metres**

**LOSAIL** (W Davis) – Late scratching at 5:09 acting on Veterinary advice after rearing in the barriers and hitting its head. All monies invested on LOSAIL to be refunded. Deductions applicable to the bets placed on the winner and place-getters prior to 5:09 – 0 cent for the win and for the place 4 cents, 2<sup>nd</sup> 4 cents the place and no third dividend. Trainer Mr J Peacock was advised that he must produce a Veterinary certificate of soundness prior to that gelding racing and trialling again.

**UNCOVERED WEALTH** (C Lloyd) – Reared as the gates opened and lost considerable ground. Rider requested to view the footage of the start to ascertain if he was denied a fair start. After

viewing the footage it was the view of the stewards that just prior to the gates opening, the filly reared high in the barriers and therefor missed the jump. Stewards declared that UNCOVERED WEALTH was not denied a fair start and declared the filly a runner.

#### **Race 4: Ladies Day April 26<sup>TH</sup> 0-58 Handicap 1200 metres**

**JESTER SMILE** (C Moon) – Crowded for room on jumping.

**BONSAI BOY** (P Marks) – Crowded at the start raced ungenerously in the early stages and was inclined to lay out throughout the event.

**MIND CRAFT** (W Davis) – Raced wide throughout the event.

**PANZANO** (T Gillett) – Underwent a veterinary examination on arriving at the barriers after attempting to buck en route to the barriers and subsequently passed fit to start. Raced wide rounding the home turn.

**GLAMOROUS** (K Gladwin) – Late scratching on Veterinary advice at 8:40 a.m. after it was found to be sore in its near side front leg. Trainer Mrs L Lefoe was advised that she must produce a veterinary certificate of soundness prior to that mare racing or trialling again. Mrs Lefoe was further advised of her obligations to notify the stewards as soon as practicable of any injuries that may require an acceptor to be scratched NT 128(2)(b).

As betting had not commenced on this event, there were no betting deductions to be made public.

**GLADIATOR** (C Lloyd) – Bumped on jumping.

**LOVE AFFAIR** (P Denton) – Knuckled on jumping

#### **Race 5: Pioneer Sprint Day May 3<sup>RD</sup> 0-64 Handicap 1400 metres**

**CONCINI** (C Moon) – Rolled out at the 100 metres and momentarily unbalanced its rider.

**WAGGABILLA** (B Huppertz) – Bumped on jumping.

**MR JANSZ** (P Crich) – Failed to maintain a forward position and raced wide throughout the event.

**RANDI** (P Marks) – Bumped on jumping.

**RANDOM SIGHTING** (K Connor) – rolled out from the 100 metres to the finish post. Rider was advised of her obligations to stop riding and straighten her mounts when they are shifting ground.

**KANGXI** (R Vigar) – Bumped at the 100 metres.
