RACE 1 OPEN HANDICAP 1000 METRES: C Haddon replaced M Hart as the rider of CALABISCA after that rider was found to be overweight.

As the gates opened, GAP EXPRESS (C Johnson) jumped awkwardly momentarily unbalancing its rider.

OUR SCENE (N Stanley) raced a little wide throughout the event.

Subsequent to this event M Hart was found guilty of a charge under AR120 (b) in that he accepted the ride on CALABISCA for which he was found to be over-weight.

M Hart was fined the sum of \$200.

RACE 2 0-58 HANDICAP 1000 METRES: As the gates opened SHEDLEY (D McIntosh) was slow into stride. On jumping DAJI (S Evans) jumped awkwardly momentarily unbalancing its rider.

As the gates opened OOLITE (N Stanley) was slow away and raced wide finishing well back.

Subsequent to this event stewards questioned N Stanley rider of OOLITE as to his instructions for that gelding and to its performance.

N Stanley advised stewards that the gelding drops out in his races and always gets home but on this occasion only ran home moderately.

RACE 3 0-69 HANDICAP 1200 METRES: As the gates opened, SINGLE COMMAND (K Gladwin) bumped GISBOURNE LAD (M Evans) which was slow away which in turn bumped ISHIEVER (C Spry) on its outside. Approaching the 600 metre, SINGLE COMMAND was inclined to lay out.

RACE 4 MAIDEN PLATE 1200 METRES: As the gates opened NOTFORGIVEN (D McIntosh) was slow into stride and CORPORAL JANE (C Johnson) brushed the side of the gates.

On jumping, A GLASS AND A HALF (C Haddon) jumped awkwardly and commenced to race ungenerously for the first 300 metres of the event.

About the 700 metre, RAVEN READY (K Gladwin) rolled of the fence which inturn caused WANNA WIN (N Stanley) to shift out and bump with NO TAX ON CASH (M Evans).

RACE 5 0-63 HANDICAP 1400 METRES: As the gates opened, PENDANCE (D McIntosh) got its head up and raced ungenerously for the first 50 metres of the event.

As the gates opened TIP STAFF (M Evans) was slow away.

About the 200 metre, DROVERS LAMENT (C JOHNSON) which was tiring rolled in onto MAKEATON (C Haddon) which was working home which inturn rolled in onto TIP STAFF and as a result FAILONGE(P Crich) on its inside was momentarily tightened along the fence.

S Evans the rider of PREMIXA dropped her whip at the 200 metre.
