RACE 1 0-64 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

On jumping TWICE BORN (M Hart) was a little slow into stride.

As the gates opened, DESTIANA (S Evans) began awkwardly momentarily unbalancing its rider.

About the 500 metres, DAJI (C Haddon) which was racing forward along the rails had to steady off the heels of MY GOOD FRIEND (K Manoukian) which was beginning to tire.

TWICE BORN raced wide with no cover throughout the event.

Mr. P Gardner was fined \$50 for presenting his runner ONTHEHUSSLE with the incorrect gear (AR.140A).

Mr. K Lamprecht trainer of BLACK JOHNNIE was fined \$50 for presenting his runner with the incorrect gear (AR.140A).

RACE 2 3YO CLASS 4 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, JON'S BREAK (K Manoukian) stood flat-footed and lost some ground.

On jumping FRENCH PROSPECT (J Cameron) was tightened momentarily between runners whilst HARREB'S LUCK (B Carlile) dipped slightly.

RACE 3 0-70 HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, MEASUREMENT (C Moon) was slow into stride.
About the 700 metres, SNELL (P Johnson) had to ease off the heels of CULLENARY DELIGHT (K Manoukian).

RACE 4 CLASS B HANDICAP 1000 METRES:

WHO'S HERE (P Crich) raced greenly in the early stages of the event.
LAGO AZZURRO (P Johnson) which was racing forward along the rails was held up for a run down the straight behind front runners and had to be checked on several occasions.

RACE 5 OPEN HANDICAP 1400 METRES:

On jumping ROBDON FLYER (K Gladwin) and GAP EXPRESS (K Manoukian) brushed.

1ST DIESELFUEL 2ND OLD GUARD 3RD ROBDON FLYER

RACE 6 0-58 HANDICAP 1400 METRES:

As the gates opened LONDON INK (S Evans) was slow into stride whilst LISTEN UP (K Adams) bumped with I SAID YES (K Manoukian) which was momentarily unbalanced.
Correct weight for this event was delayed after J Cameron the rider of the third placegetter TANAMI LADY requested to view the stewards patrol footage of the last 300 metres.

After viewing the footage correct weight was declared.

Prior to weighing out for this event J Cameron notified the stewards that she had not been engaged by the trainer of TANAMI LADY to ride in this event.

Stewards questioned Mr Lamprecht the trainer of TANAMI LADY and also J Cameron as to the circumstances surrounding her engagement for this event.

Mr Lamprecht acknowledged that he did not ring J Cameron to ride his mare rather that he just put her on.

Whilst J Cameron agreed to ride the mare in this event, stewards advised Mr. Lamprecht that in future he must ensure he engages his rider through the proper process and not to declare a rider without a verbal agreement.
