RACE 1 2YO PLATE 1000 METRES: This event was delayed due to the ambulance being late on course.

As the gates opened GUNSMITH (C Moon) was slow into stride.

HARREB'S LUCK (C Haddon) jumped a little awkwardly.

Shortly after jumping, JON'S BREAK (P Crich) began to race a little greenly and thereafter raced wide throughout the event.

After going a short distance, MR JANSZ (C Spry) had to steady off the heels of JON'S BREAK whilst electing to shift in.

1ST CASINO EXIT: N STANLEY

2ND MAYBE ALPACA: K GLADWIN

3RD GUNSMITH: C MOON

RACE 2 0-69 HANDICAP 1200 METRES: As the gates opened SOFIE FATALE (S Evans) was slow into stride.

Approaching the winning post SOFIE FATALE shifted in.

Subsequent to this event stewards ordered a veterinary inspection of MUSKETEER which had performed poorly.

The club veterinarian reported no apparent abnormalities could be found.

Ms. E Wehr, trainer of MUSKETEER was reminded by stewards in relation to removing her runner from the saddling paddock within half an hour of finishing such race AR117(3).

1ST CENTURY HILL: P DENTON

2ND BLUEHARREB: C HADDON

3RD RAINY NIGHT: M EVANS

RACE 3 3YO CLASS 4 HANDICAP 1200 METRES: As the gates opened, TOWILMI DUDE (S Evans) was slow into stride.

Rounding the 600 metre turn, PRINCESS ZIETTA (N Stanley) attempted to run off.

TOWILMI DUDE shifted in abruptly under pressure at the 250 metre.

SPIRIT BAY (J Cameron) raced wide throughout the event.

Subsequent to this event stewards questioned L Lefoe the trainer of PRINCESS ZIETTA in relation to that runner attempting to run off the track at the 600 metre.

Mrs Lefoe advised that the filly has been up racing for awhile now and could be a bit dirty on racing. Whilst Mrs Lefoe indicated that PRINCESS ZIETTA would now be spelled, stewards advised her that a similar occurrence of that filly may result in the stewards taking some action.

1ST MARSEILAISE: C HADDON

2ND POWERFUL PEGASUS: K GLADWIN

3RD TRUMBYWASARINGER: C SPRY

RACE 4 MAIDEN PLATE 1100 METRES: As the gates opened, HUGENHOLTZ (C Spry) jumped inwards tightening PONTOON FENDER (C Moon) which was a little slow away onto NOTFORGIVEN (J Cameron) which had jumped outwards.

CAN'T AGREE (P Denton) was inclined to lay in under pressure at about the 150 metre.

BUDZEAL (C Johnson) raced wide throughout the event with no cover.

1ST WANNA WIN: N STANLEY

2ND NOTFORGIVEN: J CAMERON

3RD MURPHY'S BLUEBUBBLE: K GLADWIN

RACE 5 MAIDEN PLATE 1100 METRES: On jumping WINDSOR GEM (K Gladwin) jumped outwards bumping KISTADREAMER (C Moon) and as a result KISTADREAMER knuckled and lost ground. About the 400 metre, CUTTA CUTTA BOY (C Johnson) which was beginning to race forward had to steady off the heels of WINDSOR GEM.

CUTTA CUTTA BOY was inclined to race a little green down the length of the straight.

1ST LEICA SHEIKHA: S EVANS

2ND PUT A GIRL IN IT: M EVANS

3RD NO TAX ON CASH: T GILLETT

RACE 6 0-63 HANDICAP 1000 METRES: On jumping MISS ICELAND (N Stanley) jumped outwards bumping LONDON REBECCA (K Gladwin) onto RUBY'S ANGEL (C Moon) which in turn was tightened onto GENERAL CLAUDIA (S Evans) and as a result RUBY'S ANGEL had to be checked and lost a little ground. Approaching the 600 metre MISS ICELAND which was racing forward had to steady off the heels of FAILONGE (P Crich).

Subsequent to this event K Lamprecht, trainer of ZEDESHEE was fined \$50 for presenting that gelding with incorrect gear(AR140A).

S Green, trainer of LONDON REBECCA was fined \$20 for use of the clubs colours, (NT121).

1ST THIRTY THREE BLACK: B CARLILE (A)

2ND FAILONGE: P CRICH

3RD RUBY'S ANGEL: C MOON

RACE 7 OPEN HANDICAP 1400 METRES: As the gates opened, FASTER BUSTER (M Evans) and CALABISCA (C Haddon) bumped.

1ST BLACKFORD: B CARLILE (A)

2ND CALABISCA: C HADDON

3RD CULLENARY DELIGHT: P CRICH

RACE 8 0-58 HANDICAP 1400 METRES: On jumping DIEU SOLEIL (K Gladwin) jumped awkwardly and momentarily unbalanced its rider.

As the gates opened MELCORDY SMILE (J Cameron) and CORPORATE ACTION (B Carlile) bumped whilst SWING WING (P Denton) was a little slow into stride.

Subsequent to this event M Evans the rider of ASTRAL DASH was found guilty of a charge under (AR. 137A(4)(g)) in that he used his whip when his horse was clearly winning.

Stewards ordered that M Evans forfeit his riding fee acting under AR.196.(2).

S Green, trainer of A GLASS AND A HALF was fined \$20 for use of the clubs colours, (NT121).
