RACE 1 OPEN HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, DIESELFUEL (M Hart) began awkwardly and lost a little ground whilst ALPHA GOLD (B Carlile) was tightened momentarily between runners.

About the 150 metres, ALPHA GOLD which was racing behind SOUND OF NATURE (C Moon) shifted in to commence a run and in doing so bumped with MOON MISSION (J Cameron) which was racing forward.

Correct weight was delayed after the M Hart the rider of the third placegetter DEISELFUEL requested to view the video footage of the start. After viewing the footage correct weight was declared.

Kacie Adams the rider of the fifth placegetter I CAN DO IT was reminded of her obligations to ensure that she weighs in when required after dismounting (AR.142).

RACE 2 2YO MAIDEN PLATE 1000 METRES:

As the gates opened, WITH A BULLET (B Carlile) began awkwardly and lost some ground whilst METRO (C Moon) was slow into stride.

WITH A BULLET was inclined to lay out for most of the event.

Stewards questioned B Carlile the rider of WITH A BULLET as to its poor performance. B Carlile explained that the filly had not previously been on the track at all and was a little green on the dirt.

B Carlile rider of WITH A BULLET was found guilty of a charge of using her whip when her horse was out of contention (AR.137A (4)(c)).

Stewards advised B Carlile that her mount which was in last position was in their view not making any ground rounding the home turn and down the length of the straight on the second last runner and for this reason she was in their view not entitled to use her whip in the manner she did.

Stewards acting under AR.196(2) ordered that B Carlile forfeit her riding fee for this event.

Mrs. L Lefoe trainer of MIX'N TROUBLE was found guilty of a charge under AR.140A in that she presented her runner with the incorrect gear.

Mrs. Lefoe was fined the sum of \$100.

1ST PRADA GOLD 2ND SHAWLY COCO 3RD MIX'N TROUBLE

RACE 3 MAIDEN PLATE 1400 METRES:

As the gates opened, both JONS BREAK (M Hart) and PARADISE LANE (S Evans) stood flat-footed and then bumped after jumping away momentarily unbalancing the rider of PARADISE LANE.

On jumping FAYEZEE (K Manoukian) jumped awkwardly bumping JUST GOLD (K Adams) on its inside.

Shortly after jumping JUST GOLD shifted out abruptly for a couple of strides.

Rounding the first turn WHO'S HERE (P Crich) was inclined to race a little ungenerously.

Approaching the 100 metres, HIGH PATROL (M Evans) rolled out under pressure which inturn caused SALLY CARRERA (B Carlile) to shift out tightening and momentarily unbalancing FAYAZEE onto MINNIE TIZ (C Spry).

Stewards advised M Evans rider of HIGH PATROL that in similar circumstances he must ensure that he stops riding and straighten his mounts.

1ST MINNI TIZ 2ND FAYEZEE 3RD JUST GOLD

RACE 4 0-64 HANDICAP 1000 METRES:

As the gates opened SAMALIDAN (P Crich) jumped awkwardly.

On jumping SIGNED AND SEALED (K Gladwin) made contact with OUR BLUE RIBBON (M Evans) on its outside and shortly after with TWICE BORN (M Hart) on its inside.

Approaching the 600 metres turn SNELL (C Spry) shifted out momentarily tightening SIGNED AND SEALED onto OUR BLUE RIBBON.

About the 200 metres TWICE BORN shifted out and bumped with SAMALIDAN.

1ST ROUND SATURN 2ND ENERGIZED 3RD MISS ICELAND

RACE 5 0-70 HANDICAP 1600 METRES:

On jumping both SEYMOUR SNAKE (J Cameron) and CURRENCY TRADER (B Carlile) began awkwardly momentarily unbalancing those riders.

Approaching the 1200 metres, WORK THE BODY (K Manoukian) had to steady off the heels of front runners.

Subsequent to this event stewards advised Mr. G Cooke the trainer of CURRENCY TRADER to ensure his runners are presented into the parade ring when required (AR.124).

1ST INDEED I AM 2ND CURRENCY TRADER 3RD SEYMOUR SNAKE

RACE 6 0-58 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, RAMPANT PRINCE (J Cameron) jumped awkwardly and commenced to lay out.

On jumping FRENCH PROSPECT (B Carlile) and FAST ME THINKS (C Spry) made contact.

Mr. K Lamprecht the trainer of TANAMI LADY was found guilty of a charge under AR140A in that he presented his runner with the incorrect gear.

Mr. Lamprecht was fined the sum of \$100.
