Race 1: Hahn Light 0-58 Handicap 1200 metres

WINCHESTER ARMS (P Marks) – Commenced awkwardly.

STORMY REBEL (C Lloyd) – Raced wide rounding home turn.

SET TO EXCITE (S Ridler) – Knuckled slightly on jumping.

LOVE AFFAIR (P Crich) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 2: 8HA Radio Handicap 1200 metres

SWEENEYS LANE (K Connor) – Commenced slowly and raced wide into the home straight.

GOONDI (P Denton) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 3: Imparja TV 0-70 Handicap 1100 metres

ONTHEHUSSLE (K Connor) – Knuckled on jumping and bumped. Raced wide in running and was inclined to lay in under pressure down the straight.

KEL OF A SHOT (C Moon) – Inclined to lay out rounding the home turn.

BRITISH BULLDOG (P Denton) – Despite the efforts of its rider, failed to maintain a forward position.

SOPHISTICATED LASS (W Kerford) – Bumped on jumping.

Race 4: Framptons First National Class B Handicap 1100 metres

SHARK MIRAGE (K Cross) – Inclined to lay out under pressure from about the 150m.

BONSAI BOY (P Crich) – Bumped at the 800m momentarily becoming unbalanced and was obliged to steady off the heels of front runners.

TURBO BOY (P Marks) – Knuckled on jumping.

HAND IN GLOVE (C Moon) – Shifted out abruptly at the 800m bumping another runner and commenced to race ungenerously for some distance.

General: On inquiry it was established that after being crossed clearly by GOD'S GUN near the 1000m, HAND IN GLOVE commenced to race fiercely and as a result shifted outwards abruptly and mistrode from heels making contact with BONSAI BOY which was steadied from heels. Stewards were satisfied that no one rider was at fault in this incident as it was a result of the racing manner of HAND IN GLOVE.

Race 5: Central Australian Removals 0-64 Handicap 1400 metres

CONCINI (K Cross) – Crowded for room at the start and raced wide rounding the first turn.

BLAZING COMET (C Moon) – Bumped on jumping.

CASINO EXIT (P Marks) – Momentarily crowded for room at the 100m.

RANDI (P Crich) – Bounded out of the barriers.

EMPEROR OF THE SUN (M Tyndall) – Bumped on jumping and was inclined to lay in under pressure down the length of the straight.

Race 6: HoldFast Insurance 3YO Class 6 Handicap 1400 metres

RELAY (K Gladwin) – Raced wide throughout. Crowded for room and steadied approaching the winning post.

BEST A MAN CAN GET (K Cross) – Shifted inwards shortly after the start and bumped another runner.

NEVER SATISFIED (T Gillett) – Bumped shortly after jumping. Shifted inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

ALERT BERT (M Tyndall) – Bumped shortly after the start and crowded for room.

LOSAIL (S Ridler) – Bumped shortly after start.

General: On inquiry it was established that shortly after the start, BEST A MAN CAN GET (K. Cross) shifted inwards slightly and made contact with ALERT BERT causing tightening to that runner in addition to LOSAIL and NEVER SATISFIED. Stewards were satisfied that apprentice K Cross had attempted to straighten her mount after the initial contact but despite her efforts the gelding continued to lay inwards resulting in the interference.

At a further inquiry jockey T Gillett (NEVER SATISFIED) was reprimanded for careless riding under AR 137(a) for allowing his mount to shift inwards over the concluding stages causing RELAY (K Gladwin) to be crowded and having to be steadied by its rider.
