Race 1: Sun FM Class B Handicap 1200 metres

ALWAYS RUSSIAN (K Cross) – Bumped on jumping.

SAHARA SUNRISE (K Connor) – Bumped on jumping. Returned having bled from the off-side nostril during the event. Trainer G Connor was advised that prior to that filly again starting in a barrier trial or race, it was required to undergo a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000m in the presence of a steward (AR53A(7)).

HAND IN GLOVE (C Moon) – Bumped on jumping.

FOOT ON THE TILL (M Tyndall) – Commenced awkwardly making contact with another runner. Subsequent to this event trainer Mr B Coleman advised the stewards that his gelding had sustained an injury to its mouth and as a result had lost some teeth and also sustained a deep cut to the inside of its mouth. After questioning its rider and barrier staff, it was not evident that any incident in the preliminary had caused this injury and it was concluded that the gelding's teeth must have worked loose during running. After the Veterinary surgeon confirmed the injury, Mr Coleman was notified that prior to the gelding again starting in a trial or race, he must produce a medical certificate of soundness satisfactory to the stewards.

Race 2: Feed The Mob 0-76 Handicap 1200 metres

PLANET KING (L Stojakovic) – Trainer G Connor fined \$100 for presenting his runner into the mounting yard with the incorrect gear (AR140A).

CAPACITATE (K Connor) – Bumped on jumping and raced wide throughout.

AQUIA CREEK (K Gladwin) – Bumped on jumping and crowded for room.

MIDNIGHT GIGGLE (T Gillett) – Slow into stride.

HOLLYWOOD HUSSLER (S Ridler) – Jumped outwards bumping with runner and raced wide throughout with no cover.

Race 3: Quest Apartments 0-64 Handicap 1100 metres

TRISTA RULER (T Gillett) – Prior to TRISTA RULER leaving the mounting yard, stewards questioned trainer Mr M Nyhan in regards to that gelding wearing blinkers which did not appear in the race book or in the gear advice document. Stewards were satisfied that a clerical error had occurred with notification of the blinkers and subsequently allowed the gelding to run with this gear. Underwent a veterinary inspection after becoming fractious in the barriers and was passed fit to start. Bumped on jumping.

MAYBE JUST MAYBE (M Tyndall) - Whilst making its way to the barriers the rider was dislodged and took an apparent harmless fall with the gelding galloping a short distance. After being recaptured the gelding underwent a Veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

Race 4: Indervon 2YO Plate 1000 metres

RINGWOOD RANGER (P Denton) – Slow into stride.

ROSIE'S DREAM (P Marks) – Was inclined to lay out slightly from the 400m.

WEEKENDINALICE (C Lloyd) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 5: Home and Hardware Open Handicap 1600 metres

EXTRACEED (K Connor) – Raced wide throughout.

DRAFTED (S Rowley) – Knuckled on jumping shifting out and bumping with runner. Rider advised that she had been instructed to take up forward position but due to the incident at the start she was obliged to race further back in the field. A subsequent Veterinary examination of the gelding found no apparent abnormalities.

MAHMENTUM (L Stojakovic) – Bumped on jumping.

WELLDOYA (P Denton) – Bumped heavily on jumping and crowded for room.

CASINO EXIT (M Tyndall) – Inclined to roll out under pressure over the concluding stages.

CROSS CONSTANCE (K Cross) – Jumped awkwardly.

Race 6: LandMark 0-58 Handicap 1600 metres

DISCOVERY LAD (T Gillett) – Slow away.

STRIKING COPPER (K Gladwin) – Raced wide throughout.

GLADIATOR (C Lloyd) – Bumped on jumping becoming momentarily unbalanced.

KANGXI (K Cross) – Reminded of her obligations in regards to her whip use prior to the 100m. It was established that she used her whip in the forehand manner on 1 more additional occasion than permitted under AR137A (5)(a)(ii).

GLAMOROUS (P Denton) – Slow away, steadied of front runners about the 200m.

ALERT BERT (M Tyndall) – Jumped awkwardly bumping with runner.

General Trainer G Clarke notified stewards that his gelding DEVILS DREAM was found to have an abscess in its off-fore hoof post race after the race meeting in Alice Springs on 29th March.
