## RACE 1 0-64 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, SWEET COUNTY (J Cameron) was tightened momentarily between runners.

Rounding the first turn SWEET COUNTY had to steady off the heels of MEGA MISS (K Gladwin).

Approaching the winning post, WORK THE BODY (C Johnson) bumped with VOODOO PRINCE (A Robinson) on its outside.

PHANTOM VERDE (B Hoppo) was inclined to lay in under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

K Connor rider of JOKEN JIM was found guilty of a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii). The specifics of the charge being that prior to the 100 metre mark, she used her whip in a forehand manner on 7 occasions which is 2 more than allowed under the rules. Acting under AR196 (2), stewards ordered the forfeiture of her riding fee for this event.

### RACE 2 MAIDEN PLATE 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, BELLANICIO (K Connor) stood flat-footed and lost ground. M Evans rider of CALCULATOR was found guilty of a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(i)(ii). The specifics of the charge being that prior to the 100 metre mark, he used his whip in a forehand manner on 13 occasions and in 11 consecutive strides.

Acting under AR196(2), stewards ordered the forfeiture of his riding fee and percentage in relation to this race.

#### RACE 3 2YO PLATE 1000 METRE:

EXCEEDINGLY FAST was a late scratching from this event on veterinary advice at 3:50 after injuring its near side front leg in the day stalls.

As the gates opened, SHARK MIRAGE (M Evans) jumped awkwardly losing some ground whilst DANGER MOUSE (P Denton) was slow into stride.

Rounding the home turn, DANGER MOUSE was inclined to lay out.

From about the 150 metres, SON OF LETO (C Moon) was inclined to lay in under pressure bumping NEFUD (M Evans) on its inside on several occasions.

Trainer of EXCEEDINGLY FAST Mr T Gillett was advised that prior to that filly again racing, a veterinary certificate of fitness satisfactory to the stewards must be produced. All monies invested on EXCEEDINGLY FAST withdrawn on veterinary advice at 3:50 to be refunded.

Deductions applicable to bets placed on the winner and place-getters prior to 3:50:-

1<sup>st</sup>: 7 cents the win and 10 cents the place.

2<sup>nd</sup>: 11 cents. 3<sup>rd</sup> : 10 cents.

# RACE 4 0-70 HANDICAP 1000 METRES:

As the gates opened, AGAINST THE DAY (M Evans) was slow into stride.

TWICE BORN (P Denton) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn and down the length of the straight.

## RACE 5 0-58 HANDICAP 1600 METRES:

As the gates opened, PRINCE OF TIDES (K Connor) was slow into stride. RAGTRADER (P Denton) rolled out under pressure over the concluding stages of the

### RACE 6 OPEN HANDICAP 1600 METRES;

RUSSIAN JAR (K Connor) was inclined to over race slightly in the early stages of the event.

NAVIGATION (B Hoppo) rolled in at the 150 metres bumping MYSTICAL BOND (M Evans) momentarily unbalancing that rider and close to the line rolled in again causing M Evans to steady MYSTICAL BOND off its heels after racing forward.

SEYMOUR SNAKE (S Evans) which was slow into stride on jumping raced wide throughout with no cover.

B Hoppo rider of NAVIGATION was reminded by stewards of his obligations to stop riding and straighten his mounts when they are shifting ground.
