RACE 1 0-70 HANDICAP 1000 METRES:

As the gates opened, PRINCESS ZIETTA (T O'Donnell) knuckled slightly momentarily unbalancing its rider.

Approaching the 600 metres turn, YASEEN THE LIGHT (J Cameron) shifted out bumping ONTHEHUSSLE (K Adams) which inturn caused ROUND SATURN (M Evans) on its outside to be slightly inconvenienced.

Subsequent to this event stewards questioned apprentice E Brooks regarding her riding instructions and the performance of her mount CARDHU MALT.

E Brooks advised that the trainer of the gelding Mr. Whittle would have preferred the 1200 metres and over the 1000 was just left behind before making ground down the straight.

Stewards noted E Brooks explanation.

1ST ONTHEHUSSLE 2ND YASEEN THE LIGHT 3RD OUTLOOK EXPRESS

RACE 2 2YO PLATE 1000 METRES:

As the gates opened, RED GINGER (J Cameron) jumped a little awkwardly.

CENTRE CONSUL (K Gladwin) raced wide throughout the event without cover.

1st METRO

2ND WITH A BULLETT

3RD RED GINGER

RACE 3 0-64 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, I CAN DO IT (K Adams) began a little awkwardly.

EL TORO (E Brooks) which was a little slow away raced wide through-out and rounding the home turn rolled out very wide and then raced a little erratically over the final stages of the event.

About the 1000 metres, CATCH AS CATCH CAN (M Hart) was momentarily tightened for room when trying to hold its position between I CAN DO IT on its outside and SAMALIDAN (P Denton) on its inside.

1ST CATCH AS CATCH CAN 2ND I CAN DO IT 3RD SPARKLING STONE

RACE 4 MAIDEN PLATE (1) 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, PARADISE LANE (P Crich) stood flat-footed and lost a little ground.

On jumping NORTHERN EDGE (S Evans) jumped a little awkwardly and was then tightened momentarily between runners.

FLASHANATOR (M Hart) raced wide through-out the event.

1ST MISS PERFORMER 2ND BARROSSA CHOICE 3RD FLASHANATOR

RACE 5 MAIDEN PLATE (2) 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, TWO BUN TED (C Johnson) made contact with BILLYESS (C Moon) whilst CARESSA (E Brooks) jumped a little awkwardly.

O'TOOLE (M Evans) was held up for a run behind RAMPANT PRINCE (J Cameron) from the 600 metres up until the 400 metres.

1ST RUNNING ON FAITH 2ND O'TOOLE 3RD RAMPANT PRINCE

RACE 6 0-58 HANDICAP 1600 METRES:

As the gates opened, KHAN THE TIGES (J Cameron) jumped outwards bumping PROGNOSIS (M Hart) onto SEYMOUR SNAKE (C Moon) which inturn tightened LISTENUP (K Adams) onto MINNIE TIZ (S Evans) which became momentarily unbalanced.

Approaching the 1400 metres, SIMMONA (K Gladwin) which was hanging out, tightened KHAN THE TIGES onto PROGNOSIS and as a result KHAN THE TIGES had to take hold and lost some ground.

Stewards subsequently questioned all riders involved in this incident and were of the view that no one rider was at fault and although the majority of the pressure came from

K Gladwins mount SIMMONA shifting out, he was however making a genuine effort to relieve the pressure on KHAN THE TIGES as it was hanging out.

Stewards took no further action.

FAYEZEE (P Crich) was inclined to lay out under pressure down the length of the straight.

1ST SEYMOUR SNAKE 2ND FAYEZEE 3RD TANAMI LADY

RACE 7 WFA 1400 METRES:

Both BLACKBRIAR and PALMYRA BOY were late scratchings at the barriers on Veterinary advice at 5:56 after PALMYRA BOY became cast in the barriers kicking out into the stall next to him injuring BLACKBRIAR.

Stewards advised Mr. N Dyer the trainer of PALMYRA BOY that a warning had been placed on his runner and a similar occurrence may result in some action being taken.

Ms. M Boothby trainer of BLACKBRIAR was advised that prior to that gelding again starting in a race, a veterinary certificate of soundness satisfactory to the stewards must be produced.

As the gates opened, INTO THE SUN (M Evans) jumped awkwardly and lost a little ground.

All monies invested on PALMYRA BOY and BLACKBRIAR withdrawn on Veterinary advise at 5:56 to be refunded.

Deductions applicable to the bets placed on the winner and place-getters prior to 5:56:-
For the winner 28 cents for the win, 23 cents for the place, for 2nd 28 cents 3rd 24 cents.

1ST BEL SIR 2ND OLD GUARD 3RD INTO THE SUN
