RIDER CHANGES: NIL

RACE 1 0-69 HANDICAP 1000 METRES: As the gates opened, WILD WEST (J Cameron) jumped a little awkwardly.

Approaching the 600 metre, WESTERN REBEL (B Huppertz) was inconvenienced for room momentarily after TRICE AS GOOD (B Cornell) rolled out slightly.

MACEDON CAT (M Evans) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BROOKE'S BIZZO (C Angel) was inclined to lay in under pressure from about the 150 metre.

Subsequent to this event the Club Veterinarian reported that TRICE AS GOOD had pulled up sore in the off/fore.

Mr. P Cole trainer of TRICE AS GOOD was advised that a veterinary certificate satisfactory to the stewards would be required before that gelding can again start in a race.

Mr N Dyer the trainer of BILLIE'S COURAGE was fined \$20 for the use of the club colours, (NT121).

1ST TRICE AS GOOD: B CORNELL

2ND GENERAL TYLDEN: B CARLILE (A)

3RD BROOKE'S BIZZO: C ANGEL (A)

RACE 2 0-58 HANDICAP 1100 METRES: As the gates opened both PENDANCE (B Carlile) and DISPLAY (P Denton) were slow into stride.

Approaching the 600 metre, DRAFT PICK (P Crich) which was over racing had to steady off the heels of EXPLOSIVE CHARGE (C Moon).

Rounding the home turn, OLSENS (M Evans) was forced out wide when SPREADSHEET (N Stanley) on its inside commenced to roll out.

PENDANCE was inclined to hang out rounding the home turn and down the length of the straight.

1ST EXPLOSIVE CHARGE: C MOON

2ND DISPLAY: P DENTON

3RD GIVE N 'N' GO: S HILLEBRAND

RACE 3 0-58 HANDICAP 1100 METRES: As the gates opened, INVINCIBLE GOLD (B Cornell) jumped a little awkwardly and momentarily unbalanced its rider and there after raced wide throughout with no cover.

Both GENERAL CLAUDIA (S Evans) and YOUNG ROSSA (P Crich) jumped awkwardly.

About the 400 metre GENERAL CLAUDIA hit the inside running rail.

Subsequent to this event the Club Veterinary Surgeon reported to the stewards that YOUNG ROSSA had bled from its off/side nostril.

Whilst Mr. T Wade the trainer of YOUNG ROSSA indicated to the Stewards that the gelding would now be retired, he was advised that the gelding must undergo a satisfactory gallop over 1,000 metres in the presence of a steward before it can again start in a race (AR.53A(7)).

1ST MR BUTTERSCOTCH: J CAMERON

2ND TIP STAFF: B HUPPATZ

3RD INVINCIBLE RULER: C SPRY

RACE 4 WEIGHT FOR AGE 1200 METRES: As the gates opened TEST THE SCENE (D Larsson) bumped with GAP EXPRESS (C Johnson) on its outside.

MARCO LARGO (V Arnott) which was slow into stride bumped with PERIDUKI (N Stanley).

BLUEHARREB (M Hart) raced wide with no cover throughout the event.

1ST AWE AND WONDER: C MOON

2ND GAP EXPRESS: C JOHNSON

3RD TEST THE SCENE: D LARSSON

RACE 5 0-63 HANDICAP 1200 METRES: As the gates opened HANNESBURG (C Angel) was slow into stride.

As the gates opened RUBY'S ANGEL (C Moon) jumped a little awkwardly.

1ST HANNESBURG: C ANGEL (A)

2ND SEYMOUR BUSH: C HADDON

3RD TALAMAGNE: P DENTON

RACE 6 OPEN HANDICAP 1600 METRES: As the gates opened UTILITY (P Crich) and CALABISCA (C Haddon) were slow into stride.

On the point of the first turn, ASTRAL DASH (B Huppertz) which was racing along the rails had to take hold after RAFA (P Crich) rolled in.

Subsequent to this event, stewards opened an inquiry into the incident at the point of the first turn.

Whilst the stewards acknowledge that BHuppertz the rider of ASTRAL DASH did have to take hold of his mount as RAFA shifted in, the stewards took no further action other than to advise P Crich that in similar circumstances he must ensure he is two lengths clear of runners when shifting ground.

Subsequent to this event the Club Veterinary Surgeon reported to the stewards that UTILITY had bled from its off/side nostril.

Mr. J Parnell the trainer in care for Mr. S Brown was advised by stewards that the gelding must undergo a satisfactory gallop over 1,000 metres in the presence of a steward before it can again start in a race (AR.53A(7)).

1ST RAFA: P CRICH

2ND MOON MISSION: C MOON

3RD UTILITY:S HILLEBRAND

RACE 7 NT GUINEAS 1600 METRES: As the gates opened, THE CAT (P Denton) and BABY HUEY (D Larsson) were slow into stride.

THE CAT was inclined to over-race in the early stages of the event.

Ms. L Williams the trainer of MARSEILLAISE was fined \$20 for the use of the club colours (NT121).

3RD POWERFUL PEGASUS: K GLADWIN
