RACE 1 0-58 HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

As C Moon was indisposed and unable to fulfil his riding engagements after injuring himself at track work, stewards allowed the following rider changes.

Race 1; VISION OF ONE; J Brown

Race 2; UNCOVERED WEALTH; B Hoppo

Race 3; ABERRANT; P Denton

Race 4; PITTA PATTA; K Gladwin

Race 6; BRIEF BUZZ; B Hoppo

Race 7; JUST TOO COOL; B Hoppo

Race 8; KINGNADIM; P Shiers

As A Nicholls was over-weight for the first 2 races, stewards permitted the following rider changes;

Race 1; TERRAPLEX; M Evans

Race 2; SCENT OF ATTENTION; C Johnson

As the gates opened, SOUTHBAY GIRL (K Connor) leapt in the air whilst both LOUDEST (R Vigar) and ASNA (B Hoppo) were slow away.

On jumping SKYSTAR (J Cameron) dipped slightly.

DR SCHIMMELL (P Denton) and TERRAPLEX raced wide rounding the home turn.

Subsequent to this event A Nicholls was found guilty of a charge under AR120(b) in that he accepted the rides on TERRAPLEX and SCENT OF ATTENTION for which he was found to be overweight.

A Nicholls was fined the sum of \$400 and notified of his right of appeal.

C Moon was notified that a medical certificate of fitness was required prior to him again accepting race rides.

RACE 2 2YO PLATE 1100 METRES:

Shortly after jumping, NEFUD (M Evans) shifted out causing DANGER MOUSE (P Denton) to shift out onto RED DAZZLE (J Cameron) which in turn bumped UNCOVERED WEALTH (B Hoppo) onto WALLETSINTHEWIND (K Connor) which became momentarily tightened onto PERFECT PAUSE (K Gladwin) which was commencing to shift in.

EXCEEDINGLY FAST (A Robinson) raced wide throughout with no cover.

1ST PERFECT PAUSE

2ND DANGER MOUSE

3RD NEFUD

RACE 3 0-70 HANDICAP 1100 METRE:

As the gates opened, TURNING STONE (K Gladwin) and CULLENARY DELIGHT (C Johnson) made contact and shortly after CONCINI (A Robinson) shifted out causing CULLENARY DELIGHT to steady off its heels.

Both MIDNIGHT GIGGLE (J Cameron) and AGAINST THE DAY (M Evans) raced wide throughout.

1ST ABERRANT

2ND A NIGHT IN HONKERS

3RD TURNING STONE

RACE 4 3YO CLASS 3 HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

SHAWLY COCO was a late scratching in this event by order of the stewards at 2:40 after dislodging its rider entering onto the track and galloping for some time whilst proving hard to capture.

On jumping, COUNSELLING (S Evans) bumped with PITTA PATTA (K Gladwin).

A post-race veterinary inspection of PITTA PATTA revealed that the horse had pulled up in a highly distressed state.

Whilst Ms Bell, fore-woman for Mr V Oldfield advised that the filly will now be retired, she was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness including the results of an ECG must be submitted prior to that filly having a barrier trial and then being permitted to race again.

All monies invested on SHAWLY COCO withdrawn by order of the stewards at 2:40 to be refunded.

Deductions applicable to the bets placed on the winner and place-getters prior to 2:40:-

1st 7 cents the win and 13 cents the place.

2nd 9 cents

3rd no third dividend.

1ST DASCHEM HALO

2ND CAPACITATE

3RD AS YOU DID

RACE 5 OPEN WFA 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, both PERIDUKI (R Vigar) and OUTSTANDINGLY (J Brown) were a little slow away.

DIESELFUEL (P Denton) raced wide rounding the home turn. Stewards questioned P Shiers as to the disappointing performance of his mount LUCID REFLECTION in this event.

P Shiers advised that the gelding was travelling well until the turn and then felt a little scratchy in its action before dropping out.

Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection of LUCID REFLECTION.

The club veterinary surgeon subsequently reported that whilst its recovery rate was slow, no apparent abnormalities could be found.

Trainer of LUCID REFLECTION Mr D Leech was advised that prior to that gelding again starting in a race, a veterinary certificate of fitness satisfactory to the stewards must be produced.

R Vigar rider of PERIDUKI was advised that in future he must ride his mounts out to the line when hitting the front close to home and not to presume he has the race won.

1ST PERIDUKI 2ND EXTRACEED 3RD CATCH AS CATCH CAN

RACE 6 0-62 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, BRIEF BUZZ (B Hoppo) jumped awkwardly whilst both CAPTAIN SYDNEY (M Evans) and HEART OF ETERNITY (J Cameron) were a little slow away. On jumping, THE MAN IN BLACK (C Johnson) shifted out bumping MISS ICELAND (P Denton).

DH1ST BRIEF BUZZ / BRITISH BULLDOG 2ND MISS ICELAND 3RD SILENT MOTIVE

RACE 7 0-66 HANDICAP 1600 METRES:

As the gates opened, MAYBE JUST MAYBE (W KERFORD) jumped awkwardly bumping JUST GOLD (K Connor) on its outside.

JUST GOLD had to be ridden hard in the early stages of the event.

Approaching the 200 metres, MYSTICAL BOND (K Gladwin) shifted out slightly under pressure.

1ST MAYBE JUST MAYBE 2ND HOLLYWOOD AND VINE 3RD MYSTICAL BOND

RACE 8 OPEN HANDICAP 1900 METRES:

Approaching the 1200 metre turn, RUSSIAN JAR (K Connor) was inclined to over race up onto the heels of KINGNADIM (P Shiers).

1ST AQUIA CREEK 2ND BACCHUS EAGLE 3RD GAP EXPRESS

Post-race samples were taken from all winners.

Pre-race sample were taken from; Race 7 JUST TOO COOL
Race 8; KINGNADIM

All riders were breath tested for alcohol.
