RACE 1 0-70 HANDICAP 1100METRES:

As the gates opened, BAYLEY BIRDS (S Evans) jumped a little awkward whilst TWICE BORN (M Hart) was slow into stride.

YASEEN THE LIGHT (J Cameron) commenced to roll out from about the 700 metres taking WHO SHOT THE ANGEL (B Huppatz) out wide and as a consequence WHO SHOT THE ANGEL was forced to momentarily take hold and change course back to the inside.

J Cameron rider of YASEEN THE LIGHT was advised to be mindful of other riders around her when allowing her mounts to shift ground.

Correct weight for this event was delayed after S Evans rider of BAYLY BIRDS requested to view the head-on footage of the start as she was of the opinion that her mount may have been denied a fair start.

After viewing the patrol footage S Evans withdrew her concern and correct weight was declared.

RACE 2 2YO DASH 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened SHAWLY COCO (K Gladwin) knuckled momentarily unbalancing its rider.

On jumping CAPACITATE (K Adams) jumped a little awkwardly and then commenced to race greenly in the early stages of the event.

About the 150 metres, MIXN TROUBLE (M Hart) had to steady off the heels of CAPASITATE which had rolled in under pressure.

1ST SHAWLY COCO 2ND PRADA GOLD 3RD RED GINGER

RACE 3 3YO CLASS 3 HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, MISS PERFORMER (B Huppatz) shifted out making contact with DESERT VIPER (C Moon) on its outside.

AFTONLAND (M Evans) raced wide throughout without cover.

Mrs L Lefoe trainer of PRIVATE DOWNS was found guilty of a charge under AR.140A in that she presented her runner with the incorrect gear.

Mrs Lefoe was fined the sum of \$200.

Mr. K Lamprecht trainer of DESERT VIPER was fined \$100 for failing to declare its rider by the prescribed time (NT.129).

1ST PRIVATE DOWNS 2ND COMMAND RULER 3RD MISS PERFORMER

RACE 4 OPEN HANDICAP 1000 METRES:

As the gates opened, DREAM FACE (C Moon) and HIDDEN SURPRISE (B Cornell) made contact whilst COURTING MAGIC (P Crich) dipped slightly.

HAND OUT (E Brooks) raced wide throughout with no cover.

1ST DREAM FACE 2ND FAR HORIZANS 3RD OUTSTANDINGLY

RACE 5 MAIDEN PLATE 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, AQUIA CREEK (C Johnson) knuckled whilst CALIGULA KID (K Adams) bumped with DASHING HARRY (J Cameron).

Approaching the 150 metres, BILLYESS (B Cornell) had to ease off the heels of AQUIA CREEK which had rolled in.

C Johnson rider of AQUIA CREEK was subsequently advised that under similar circumstances he must react quicker when straightening his mounts that are shifting ground.

MAX MAX (M Hart) raced wide throughout without cover.

K Gladwin rider of BAROSSA CHOICE dropped his whip at the 250 metres.

1ST FLASHANATOR 2ND O'TOOLE 3RD DASHING HARRY

RACE 6 0-58 HANDICAP 1400 METRES:

HODGE was a late scratching from this event at 4:04 on Veterinary advice after dislodging its rider (C Johnson) on the way to the barriers and galloping a circuit of the track.

As the gates opened, PARCHED (M Evans) was a little slow into stride.

Subsequent to this event stewards reminded M Hart rider of PROGNOSIS of his obligations in regards to using his whip when his mounts are out of contention and showing no response after his mount finished a distant last.

All monies invested on HODGE withdrawn by order of the stewards on Veterinary advice at 4:04 to be refunded.

Deductions applicable to the bets placed on the winner and place-getters prior to 4:04:-
For the winner 0 cents the win, 6 cents the place, for 2nd 4 cents, 3rd 5 cents.

RACE 7 0-76 HANDICAP 1400 METRES:

As the gates opened, BANDIT COUNTRY (K Gladwin) jumped inwards bumping THE CAT (P Crich) on its inside which was a little slow into stride.

CURRENCY TRADER (T O'Donnell) raced very wide rounding the first turn and then raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 8 WEIGHT FOR AGE 1600 METRES:

As the gates opened EL TORO (K Gladwin) was tightened momentarily between runners whilst GRANZIG (M Hart) was a little slow into stride.

On jumping SEYMOUR SNAKE (C Moon) and BOOM TRADER (C Spry) made contact.
