## **Race 1 – TROBIS Class B HCP - 1300 metres:**

Acting on a telephone call from trainer Mr J Manning advising that ROCKING MADICA had played up in the float and was not fit to travel stewards ordered the withdrawal of ROCKING MADICA at 8.30 am.

LUMINOUS was slow to muster speed when the gates opened.

Rounding the turn COPPIN had a tendency to lay out.

Approaching the 600 metres AQUAINT which was held up for a clear run shifted out to obtain a clear run and came into contact with COME BY SUNDAY.

Mr D Jupp trainer of COPPIN and LUMINOUS, Ms T Halter trainer of ROCKAHULA BABY and Mr C Pollard trainer of COME BY SUNDAY were all fined \$100 for presenting their respective horses late in the mounting yard (AR 124).

## **Race 2 – 0 - 70 HCP - 1100 metres:**

When the gates opened TIDALZONE jumped awkwardly and bumped with MOUSAL which shifted out slightly.

Racing past the 600 metres to the first turn TIDALZONE hung in badly tightening MOUSAL on its inside. The tightening continued for some distance resulting in MOUSAL having to be eased and losing its running.

## **Race 3 – 0 - 64 HCP - 1600 metres:**

Having viewed the photo finish image connections advised that they were not satisfied with the judges placings. Connections then requested to view the

stewards patrol film of the race. Stewards denied their request to view the stewards patrol film prior to correct weight. As the judge was satisfied with his original placing's and as stewards agreed with the judges placings correct weight was declared.

Subsequent to the event the Club's Veterinary Surgeon reported that LUKE'S COURAGE was suffering the effects of heat stress.
