RACE 1 0-76 HANDICAP 1100METRES:

P Crich replaced A Nicholls as the rider of CONCINI after that rider was unable to make the weight.

As the gates opened, SNOOP (S Evans) began awkwardly momentarily unbalancing its rider.

SUNDAY PSALM (K Manoukian) knuckled shortly after jumping whilst RETURN TO (D Larsson) raced a little erratic after jumping.

Both RETURN TO and SUNDAY PSALM were inclined to roll out down the length of the straight.

A Nicholls was found guilty of a charge under AR120(b) in that he accepted the ride on CONCINI for which he was found to be over-weight.

A Nicholls was fined the sum of \$200.

RACE 2 0-58 HANDICAP HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

Upon arriving at the barriers, CHURCHI underwent a veterinary inspection and was subsequently passed fit to start.

Shortly after jumping, PERFECT RENDITION (S Evans) shifted in bumping GET CLOSER (D Larsson) which inturn bumped STORMY REBEL (C Moon) on its outside. RUBY'S ANGEL (A Nicholls) was inclined to drop out in the early stages of the event. LITTLE DEUTER GIRL (P Crich) raced wide throughout whilst RUBY'S ANGEL shifted out wide rounding the home turn and continued to race wide down the length of the straight.

Mrs. L Lefoe trainer of CHURCHI was notified by stewards that a warning would be placed on that filly after being unruly on the way to the barriers almost dislodging its rider and crashing into the inside running rail.

Mrs. Lefoe was advised that a similar occurrence may result in some action being taken.

RACE 3 BENCHMARK 65 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

D Larsson replaced A Nicholls as the rider of GENARKA STAR after that rider was found to be overweight.

As the gates opened, HOLD THE ACES (D Tootell) jumped a little awkward.

AUSBRED ROYAL (P Crich) and GOOD DECISION (C Moon) made contact.

Shortly after jumping CATCH AS CATCH CAN (M Evans) shifted in bumping with AUSBRED ROYAL.

SINGLE COMMAND (K Manoukian) raced wide rounding the home turn and down the length of the straight.

Subsequent to this event stewards ordered a veterinary inspection of both CATCH AS CATCH CAN and BELLEVELON.

THE CLUB Veterinary surgeon reported that CATCH AS CATCH CAN was sore in the near fore hoof area and no apparent abnormalities could be found with BELLEVELON.

Trainer of CATCH AS CATCH CAN, R Bell was advised that prior to again racing a veterinary certificate satisfactory to the stewards must be produced.

Trainer of BELLEVELON L Lefoe notified stewards that the mare would now be spelled.

1ST CATCH AS CATCH CAN 2ND GOOD DECISION 3RD HOLD THE ACES

RACE 4 CLASS B HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened O'TOOLE (M Evans) was slow into stride.

On jumping CONVINCING (K Manoukian) jumped awkwardly inconveniencing RANDI (D Tootell) on its outside which was a little slow away and BILLYESS (D Larsson) on its outside which was bumped and was momentarily unbalanced.

HIGH PATROL (S Evans) raced a little erratic in the early stages of the event and was inclined to lay out for most of the race.
