RACE 1 0-64 HANDICAP 1200METRES:

As the gates opened, RAMPANT PRINCE (S Evans) and SHASTA MOON (P Johnson) made contact whilst both BAYLEY BIRDS (C Spry) and AGAINST THE DAY (M Evans) were slow into stride.

BAYLEY BIRDS was inconvenienced for a run from about the 200 metres between WESTERN REBEL (C Johnson) on its outside and AGAINST THE DAY on its inside.

RACE 2 MAIDEN PLATE 1000 METRES:

As the gates opened, A GLASS AND A HALF (P Johnson) jumped outwards causing its rider some difficulty in keeping straight and in doing so bumped with DEFAMATORY (B Hoppo) which was a little slow away which inturn bumped MYLADY CAROL (M Evans) on its outside.

Subsequent to this event stewards questioned Mr. B Coleman trainer of A GLASS AND A HALF as to its behaviour on jumping and its overall poor performance in this event. Mr. Coleman advised that the gelding had never tried to run off after jumping in its previous starts and further added that the gelding will now be retired.

RACE 3 BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP 1400 METRES:

As the gates opened, CROSS CONSTANCE (B Hoppo) jumped a little awkwardly whilst GEOESPRIT (S Evans) stood flat-footed and lost some ground.

About the 450 metres, GEOESPRIT which was starting to race forward had to check off the heels of the tiring CROSS CONSTANCE which was losing ground.

RACE 4 CLASS B HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, CARNEGGAN DASHER (T O'Donnell) was slow into stride whilst HIGH PATROL (C Johnson) made contact with JUST GOLD (C Atkinson).
