RACE 1 0-69 HANDICAP 1200 METRES: As the gates opened FOOTFULLABINDIES (C Johnson) jumped awkwardly and lost a little ground.

On jumping ISHIEVER (C Spry) knuckled and lost ground whilst CRISTAMBUL (B Carlile) was tightened between runners.

CRISTAMBUL was inclined to over race in the early stages of the event.

ROYAL BOND (L Stojakovic) raced wide throughout the event with no cover.

Subsequent to the event the Club Veterinary surgeon reported that ISHIEVER had bled from its off/side nostril. Mrs. R Lamprecht, foreman for Mr. K Lamprecht was advised that prior to that Mare again starting in a race it must gallop over 1,000 metres to the satisfaction of the Stewards (AR.53A (7)).

1ST GOOD DECISION: T GILLETT

2ND ROCAMADOUR: M L EVANS

3RD POWERFUL PEGASUS: C MOON

RACE 2 0-58 HANDICAP 1200 METRES: On jumping BROOKE'S BIZZO (M Hart) was a little awkwardly into stride.

GIVE ME SOME (C Spry) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn.

1ST SPINNG APPLE: L STOJAKOVIC (A)

2ND LISTENUP: M L EVANS

3RD SKYCONI: C MOON

RACE 3 MAIDEN PLATE 1100 METRES: As the gates opened, A GLASS AND A HALF (L Stojakovic) bumped with DOUBLE ZED (M Hart) on its outside which inturn shifted out abruptly momentarily unbalancing its rider.

Shortly after jumping SERIOUS VALUE (M L Evans) bumped with A GLASS AND A HALF causing that gelding to be placed off stride momentarily.

RACE 4 BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP 1400 METRES: LUCERNE VALE (C Johnson) was fractious in the barriers.

As the gates opened REGANSBURG (M L Evans) was a little slow into stride.

Rounding the first turn, THIRTY THREE BLACK (C Spry) was inclined to lay out.

Subsequent to this event stewards questioned C Spry rider of THIRTY THREE BLACK as to its disappointing performance.

C Spry advised the Stewards that the gelding did not want to improve in its position and may need blinkers to get its mind back on the job.

RACE 5 0-63 HANDICAP 1400 METRES: As the gates opened, TOWIME DUDE (M L Evans) was slow into stride.

- 1ST JUST RORY: M HART**
2ND BLACK LOOT: C SPRY
3RD SINGLE COMMAND: C MOON
