Race 1: Central Australian Removals 0-70 Handicap 1200 metres

HAWK HUNTER (B Huppatz) – Bumped on jumping.

VISION OF ONE (S Rowley) – Shifted inwards near the 650m.

CLANGGAJANG (K Cross) – Bumped on jumping.

WINCHESTER ARMS (R Agnew) – Tightened for room and restrained near the 650m.

DISCOVERY LAD (D Pisani) – Momentarily tightened between runners on jumping.

General: On inquiry apprentice jockey S Rowley who was represented by trainer Mr N Moody, pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a). The specifics being that near the 650m she permitted her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear resulting in WINCHESTER ARMS (R Agnew) being tightened for room and restrained by its rider. S Rowley had her licence to ride in races suspended for a period of (1) NT meeting commencing midnight the 8TH June up until and including the 14TH June. Stewards when considering penalty were of the view that the degree of carelessness and the interference were in the low range and also S Rowley's good record.

Race 2: Hahn Light Class B Handicap 1200 metres

LADY PHROMILY (P Denton) – Slow into stride.

BIG EGO ROCK (W Davis) – Raced wide throughout.

CROISSANTS (K Gladwin) – Dwelt on jumping.

COOPER'S SHOUT (T Kirkpatrick) – Jumped awkwardly shifting outwards.

UNCOVERED WEALTH (B Huppatz) – Slow away.

FERICELLE (R Agnew) – Raced wide throughout.

General: Stewards interviewed licenced trainer Mr J Luele in regards to the incorrect gear information with two of his runners today. It was established that Mr Luele had notified RISA of his gear requests but due to a clerical error the prescribed gear did not reflect that in the race book. Stewards were satisfied that Mr Luele had followed the correct procedures for the gear request and therefor allowed his runners to race with the gear he had requested. Trainer Mrs L Gillett was fined \$100 for presenting her runner BEST A MAN CAN GET with the incorrect gear (AR140A).

Race 3: Pioneer Park BenchMark Handicap 1000 metres
MEMORABLE MOMENT (K Gladwin) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 4: Unibet 0-58 Handicap 1000 metres

NEXT IN LINE (T Gillett) – Tightened for room on jumping and commenced to race wide from the 600m.

RELAY (J Cameron) – Fractious in the barriers and bumped on jumping.

TROFEO (K Cross) – Bumped on jumping.

VOODOO PRINCE (M Henderson) – Raced wide throughout.

HARD NUT TO CRACK (T Kirkpatrick) – Steadied outwards off heels at about the 100m.

Race 5: The Rock Bar 0-64 Handicap 1400 metres

THREELEGSAGAIN (B Huppatz) – Bumped on jumping.

WESTEND SMASH (R Agnew) – Bumped on jumping.

STORMY REBEL (M Henderson) – Jumped awkwardly and commenced to race wide rounding the first turn.

Post-Race samples were taken from all winners.

Pre –Race samples were taken from;- Race 5: CROSS CONSTANCE

All riders were breath tested for alcohol.
