**Race 1 – TROBIS Class B HCP - 1200 metres:**

When the start was effected GLOBAL CRISIS jumped awkwardly and took some distance to muster speed.

CORDELIA stumbled on jumping away and lost some ground.

PINOT NOIR stood flat footed and failed to jump with the field.

The Clubs Veterinary Surgeon inspected PINOT NOIR which finished well back in the field and reported that the gelding was lame in the near fore leg.

Mr T Balfour, trainer of PINOT NOIR was advised that prior to the gelding racing again he must provide a satisfactory veterinary certificate.

**Race 2 – 0 – 70 HCP - 1100 metres:**

Shortly after the start PASS THE TEST had to be eased momentarily when JACOPO shifted in slightly.

**Race 3 – 0 – 58 HCP - 1600 metres:**

After being placed in the barriers RAPT TO GOGO reared and became cast dislodging it's rider Ms M Tyndall. Stewards ordered the withdrawal of RAPT TO GOGO at 3:50pm.

Stewards ordered all monies wagered on RAPT TO GOGO to be refunded and all monies wagered on the event prior to the withdrawal of RAPT TO GOGO to be paid as follows:-

On the home run TEHUTI was taken wide by SPEECH ROOM which shifted out.

Subsequent to the event Ms M Tyndall was examined by the medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

**Race 4 – 0 – 64 HCP – 1200 metres:**

MARRIED MAN dwelt when the start was effected and conceded some ground as a consequence.

After passing the 900 metre MARRIED MAN (A Brown) shifted in over a number of strides tightening ANOTHER BAY in onto PROPHETS. ANOTHER BAY and PROPHETS came together resulting in PROPHETS hitting the running rail, then shifting out and bumping ANOTHER BAY on the hindquarters. As a result both ANOTHER BAY and PROPHETS were hampered.

Stewards reprimanded Ms A Brown and advised her that in future she must ensure she leaves sufficient room for other runners on her inside.

Approaching the 600 metres MARRIED MAN shifted out, as a result ALMADINE which was racing to its outside was taken out and had to be eased to avoid its heels.

Stewards reprimanded Ms S Montgomerie rider of RICCARDO THE GREAT and Mrs K Connor rider of JOKEN JIM for using their whips on their respective mounts excessively. Both riders were advised that going forward they should endeavour to break up their whip use and allow their mounts an opportunity to respond without the whip.

The Clubs Veterinary Surgeon inspected PROPHETS subsequent to the event and reported that he could find no apparent abnormality.

**Race 5 – HCP – 1200 metres:**

FITNESS FANATIC bounded as the gates opened and conceded some ground as a consequence.

Shortly after jumping away GENEROUS BEAU shifted out taking INTO THE SUN out across the running of FITNESS FANATIC onto RED COLOSSUS.

**Race 6 – 0 – 70 HCP – 1300 metres:**

IT'S HOME shifted out on jumping away and tightened RUSSIAN JAR.

Licensed stablehand Mr M Foote was fined \$100 under AR87AAA for riding trackwork on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June at the Fannie Bay Racecourse in the dark without a working safety warning light as required by the rule.

Mr D Leech, visiting trainer, was reprimanded for leading two horses in contravention of stewards direction. Mr Leech was reminded that the practise of leading 2 horses had been banned for many years and any future occurrence would lead to a penalty being imposed.

The following riders were drug and alcohol tested today; Ms K Connor, Ms F Bergstrand, Mr B Davis, Mr A Stead.

Swab samples were taken from all winners.

Pre race samples were taken from REGAL ATTITUDE, VERSEMAN, BOBS A DAZZLER, RED COLOSSUS, INTO THE SUN, RUSSIAN JAR.
