From DTC meeting 14 June, 2014

Race 1 – Apprentice F Bergstrand (EKSUM) was reprimanded for a breach of AR137A(5)(ii) in that she used her whip in the forehand manner on 1 additional occasion more than permitted prior to the 100m.

**General** – As apprentice S Rowley was indisposed due to injury, Stewards approved the following riding changes:

R1 – ROMAN EYE – A. Brown      R3 – MYKINDACOLOUR – P Shiers (no apprentice available)  
R4 – RELAY – M Tyndall      R6 – ALPHA CAT – C Lloyd (no apprentice available)

#### **Race 1: Parap Villiage Apartments 1200 metres**

**HILLBILLY RICH** (B Huppertz) – Bumped outwards and unbalanced near the 750m and raced wide thereon.

**BELLE EZ** (J Todd) – Fractious prior to the start. Lay inwards under pressure in the straight.

**TIGERKELLY** (M Tyndall) – Proved difficult to load. Cast its near hind plate in running.

**HAZEROTH** (K Connor) – Steadied leaving the 800m and taken outwards across heels to improve and in doing so bumped with another runner. Impeded when under pressure near the 50m.

**General:** On inquiry it was established that leaving the 800m HAZEROTH (K Connor) was steadied and then taken outwards to improve resulting in HILLBILLY RICH (B Huppertz) being bumped outwards and unbalanced. Apprentice K Connor was reprimanded for careless riding under AR 137(a) for allowing her mount to shift ground when not clear in this incident.

Jockey J Todd (DEVIL'S Dream) was shown a replay of an incident in the home straight in which he had continued to ride his mount along whilst it was laying inwards which resulted in HAZEROTH being impeded near the 50m. Jockey J Todd was advised to stop and straighten his mounts in similar circumstances.

#### **Race 2: Scriven Exploration Maiden Plate 1100 metres**

**ART FOR ARTS SAKE** (J Todd) – Bumped at the start.

**FINALLY OVER** (C Lloyd) – When questioned regarding the unplaced performance rider advised that after being crossed by another runner near the 800m, his mount resented the kickback and consequently lost ground through the middle stages. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**PIPPINGARRA** (A Brown) – Cast its near hind plate in running.

**SOLAR CHARM** (B Huppertz) – Lay outwards in running and raced wide throughout.

**Race 3: Darwin RSL 0 – 58 Handicap 1300 metres****AGADEV** (K Gladwin) – Raced wide from the 800m.**RANDI** (B Huppatz) – Raced wide throughout.**BOURSE** (M Tyndall) – Commenced to yield ground from the 600m.**GOLD RISES** (S Hillebrand) – Crowded shortly after the start.**ROYAL REQUEST** (J Todd) – Taken outwards to secure clear running on straightening. Lay inwards in the straight with the rider changing the whip to his left hand near the 150m.**Race 4: PSC Insurance Brokers TROBIS Three-Years-Old Class 4 Handicap 1300 metres****GRAVITATIONAL** (P Shiers) – Impeded behind heels and unable to improve between the 800m and the 700m.**DEFLECTION** (W Davis) – Raced wide throughout.**Race 5: Bernborough Club Cup 1000 metres****SHTARKER** (C Lloyd) – Raced wide throughout.**Race 6: MBA Insurance Brokers Handicap 1600 metres****LAGO COMO** (P Shiers) – Following the unplaced performance, a post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind. Trainer Mr W Savage was advised that he must present a veterinary certificate of soundness prior to the gelding racing again.**BENTLY TYCOON** (J Todd) – Raced wide from the 600m. Cast its off hind plate in running.**ALPHA CAT** (C Lloyd) – Raced wide from the 600m.**General:**

Trainer Mr S Brown was fined \$100 (AR 140A) for presenting SHTARKER (R5) to race with incorrect gear.

Trainer Mrs K Hughes was reprimanded (AR 175k) for negligence in allowing an unlicensed person to attend to one of her horses on race day. In arriving at this penalty Stewards considered the circumstances relating to the incident.

Post race swab samples were taken from all winners.

Pre race samples were taken from DYNAMICS (R3), GOLD RISES (R3), WHISTLE STOP (R4), REARRY (R4), HEZASMARTYPANTS (R6), WATCHT SPACE (R6).
