Race 1 – 2-Y-O Set Weights - 1000 metres:

CRISTI MORN dwelt when the gates opened and conceded ground as a consequence.

Rounding the turn CRISTI MORN hung out and raced wide. Mr J Manning trainer of CRISTI MORN was advised that a warning would be issued against the filly and if it was to perform in a similar manner in the future some action may be taken.

1st RINGWOOD MAGIC 2nd COOPERS SHOUT 3rd CRISTI MORN

Race 2 – MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 metres:

No Report.

1st GLOBAL CRISIS 2nd MISSION IMPOSSIBLE 3rd MEADOWS MIST

Race 3 – TROBIS 0 – 58 HCP - 1200 metres:

CORDELIA which jumped away slowly was hampered shortly after by LETS FACE IT which shifted in abruptly.

COOL OPERATOR knuckled shortly after jumping away.

Approaching the 500 metres BOURSE which was racing ungenerously had to be eased when disappointed for a run on the inside of NEXT IN LINE which was racing tight on its outside. BOURSE rolled in when eased resulting in QUITE A GEM which was attempting a run to its inside having to be checked. As no one rider was responsible stewards took no action.

Mr J Stanton trainer of BOURSE was fined \$100 for presenting that gelding with incorrect gear (AR 140A)

1st SPEECH ROOM 2nd NEXT IN LINE 3rd FINE GOLD

Race 4 – 0 – 62 HCP – 1100 metres:

On jumping away MISS BEC was tightened for room between BLACK MARIA and BATTLE READY both of which shifted. As a result MISS BEC was badly hampered.

Miss A Brown rider of REDANGELO was found guilty of a charge of careless riding (AR 137(a)).

The careless riding being that after passing the 1000 metres she permitted her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of MISS BEC resulting in MISS BEC having to be checked. Ms Brown was suspended from riding in races for a period to expire at midnight on Saturday 6th July (one meeting). Stewards took into account that Ms Brown had not been suspended for careless riding previously.

1st PERSONA GRATA 2nd ROYAL KELLY 3rd BATTLE READY

Race 5 – 0 - 76 HCP - 1100 metres:

YELLOW JERSEY reared as the start was effected and lost some ground as a consequence.

On jumping away ALERT THE JEWELLER which was slow into stride was bumped by FRUPPER which shifted in.

SEA GEM bounded as the gates opened causing its rider to become unbalanced. SEA GEM then shifted out abruptly.

Mr B Davis rider of DREAMING OF NEPAL was found guilty of a charge of careless riding (AR137(a)). The details being that near the 650 metres he permitted his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of YELLOW JERSEY resulting in YELLOW JERSEY clipping the heels of DREAMING OF NEPAL. Mr B Davis was suspended from riding in races for a period to expire at midnight on Saturday 6th July (one meeting).

1st FRUPPER 2nd DREAMING OF NEPAL 3rd ALERT THE JEWELLER

Race 6 – 0 – 66 HCP – 1600 metres:

Mr J Stanton trainer of HIRAFU advised the stewards that he would be requesting the geldings rider to attempt to race mid field today.

HAULAGE was slow to begin when the gates opened.

BOBS A DAZZLER and TORNADO JACK came together on jumping away.

In the early stages HAULAGE over raced and got its head up when being eased.

In the early and middle stages of the race HIRAFU got its head up when being restrained.

Near the 900 metres FALDANE had to be eased to avoid racing up on the heels of TORNADO JACK which was over racing.

1st OUT OF THE DESSERT 2nd LE BEAU CHEVAL 3rd TORNADO JACK

Race 7 – GOLD CUP – 1600 metres:

BOLTON bounded when the start was effected and lost some ground.

D Smith rider of RED COLOSSUS was reprimanded for using his whip on that gelding unnecessarily when that gelding was clearly winning (AR137A(4)(g)).

1st RED COLOSSUS 2nd IGLES STAR 3rd I AM MAGIC

Race 8 – 0 – 70 HCP – 1200 metres:

On jumping away JOLLIENCE shifted out taking MORE BUBBLY out onto BEL SIR.

CHEVILLE jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SWEENEYS LANE.

SWEENEYS LANE then continued out onto SAMILADAN.

Near the 950 metres MORE BUBBLY rolled in resulting in JOLLIENCE having to be eased slightly when tightened in onto NADAKA.

1st CHEVILLE 2nd NADAKA 3rd MORE BUBBLY

Swab samples were taken from all winners.
