**Race 1 – TROBIS 2-Y-O PLATE - 1100 metres:**

On arrival at the barriers LOW EXPECTATION was re-saddled.

TOP OF THE WORLD which was racing greenly attempted to hang out rounding the turn.

**Race 2 – 0 – 58 Handicap - 1600 metres:**

On jumping away TEHUTI was slow into stride.

Approaching the 1100 metres HIRAFU which was over racing had to be eased.

After passing the 1000 metres LUMINOUS was eased after running up onto the heels of POSEN.

Mr D Jupp, trainer of LUMINOUS was fined \$100 for incorrect gear on that gelding AR140 A.

**Race 3 – 0 – 66 Handicap - 1100 metres:**

Shortly after the gates opened MYSTICAL BOND jumped out onto PASS THE TEST, which then made contact with SO REAL on its outside.

At approximately the 650 metres Ms F Bergstrand, rider of CORONA GIRL eased to avoid the heels of PRESIDIUUM which was racing forward.

During the event RIALIO lost both front plates.

Subsequent to the event the Clubs Veterinary surgeon reported RIALIO was lame in both fore legs.

Mr G Clarke trainer of RIALIO will be notified that a satisfactory veterinary certificate must be produced prior to that gelding racing again.

**Race 4 – 0 – 62 Handicap – 1300 metres:**

On jumping away NEXT IN LINE jumped out taking RICCARDO THE GREAT out onto CAPACITATE and REDANGELO. REDANGELO was forced across the heels of THE LAST GENERAL resulting in REDANGELO losing some ground.

Approaching the 1100 metres MAGNIFICENT SEVEN drifted outwards taking NEXT IN LINE out onto RICCARDO THE GREAT, that gelding then bumped CAPACITATE out onto REDANGELO which was forced across the heels of A CITY GIRL. CAPACITATE was also taken across the heels of THE LAST GENERAL.

**Race 5 – FILLIES & MARES 0 – 70 Handicap - 1300 metres:**

As Mr A Thompson, the declared rider of RISKY BLONDE was unable to ride at the allotted weight and there were no other suitable senior riders available stewards allowed apprentice Ms M Tyndall to replace him as the rider of that mare.

On arrival at the barriers the Clubs Veterinary Surgeon inspected WELCOME RETURN and passed that mare fit to run.

When the gates opened RISKY BLONDE jumped out onto MISS BEC forcing that mare onto the hindquarters of MANGO MOJITO which in turn bumped NERO MACHINO.

Stewards questioned Ms V Arnott, rider of MORE BUBBLY in regards to that mare getting back in the early stages of the race. Ms Arnott stated that the mare had not raced back in previous starts unlike today and had resented the dirt being kicked back.

The Clubs Veterinary surgeon inspected MORE BUBBLY subsequent to the event and reported no abnormalities detected.

Mr A Thompson was fined the sum of \$100 for accepting a ride for which he was found overweight (AR120(b)).

**Race 6 – 0 – 76 Handicap – 1600 metres:**

WELLDROYA was slow into stride.

At the 650 metres RUSSIAN JAR attempted to lay in forcing SPEECH ROOM to make contact with HIERARCHY on its inside.

**Race 7 – SC Handicap – 1300 metres:**

When the gates opened MUCHOS RESPECTOS jumped out onto MOSSADINA, THE THEIF also jumped inwards onto SENSE OF SUN.

On jumping away CATCH AS CATCH CAN got its head up.

Approaching the 1000 metres MUCHOS RESPECTOS, which drifted out slightly eased off the heels of CATCH AS CATCH CAN.

Entering the straight MUCHOS RESPECTOS was held up for a clear run behind SENSE OF SUN.

At approximately the 200 metres CATCH AS CATCH CAN and REFLEX came together.
