### **Race 1 National Seniors Aust. Central Australia Branch Handicap 1200 metres**

**CESTOS** (K Gladwin) – Bumped with another runner on jumping.  
**ESTAMBUL THIRTEEN** (L Crow) – Bumped with another runner on jumping.  
**MEET MY BRO** (M Tyndall) – Bumped with another runner on jumping and raced wide early.  
**MR GOODLOOKING** (W Kerford) – Unbalanced between runners on jumping and raced wide entering into the straight.  
**PAZZIMY** (D Pisani) – Slow into stride.

### **Race 2: CKS Electrical and Lights N Fanz R Us Handicap 1100 metres**

**BLAME IT ON RIO** (K Brooks) – Slow into stride and raced wide. Inclined to roll in under pressure nearing the finish.  
**HARADIS EAGLE** (K Gladwin) – Commenced awkwardly losing some ground and raced wide throughout.  
**WILD RUN** (D Pisani) – Knuckled slightly on jumping.

### **Race 3: Sing Australia Handicap 1100 metres**

Prior to this race Stewards interviewed trainer Mrs L Gillett in regards to the riding instructions she intended to give each rider bearing in mind she had 4 runners engaged in this event.

**THEATREMAN** (K Gladwin) – Bumped with another runner on jumping.  
**AUSBRED ROYAL** (M Tyndall) – Commenced a little awkward and was inclined to lay out throughout the event.  
**AUSBRED CUTIE** (R Vigar) – Bumped with another runner on jumping and raced wide throughout.

**Race 4: Kathys Place Bed and Breakfast Handicap 1400 metres**

**COLDROCK** (K Brooks) – Began a little awkward bumping with another runner.

**CASINO EXIT** (D Pisani) – Bumped with another runner on jumping and momentarily tightened between runners.

**RANDI** (R Vigar) – Bumped with another runner on jumping. Was found to have bled from one nostril on returning to scale. Trainer Mr Lamprecht was advised that the gelding was now subject to the requirements of AR53A(7).
