Race 1: 0-70 Handicap 1100 metres

NEAT FEAT (R Oakford) – Proved difficult to load.

PHERENICE (B Huppatz) – Slow into stride.

Race 2: Maiden 1000 metres

ALIBODACIOUS (D Pisani) – Was declared a late scratching at 8.16am when trainer Ms L Walling – Denton advised that the gelding had injured itself whilst being prepared for transport to the meeting.

EXCELLENT ROSE (M Tyndall) – Fractious prior to the start.

KAPPII (C Spry) – Slow into stride.

MONDO MISS (B Huppatz) – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

ON MY SAY SO (B Davis) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 3: BM54 TROBIS Handicap 1300 metres

QUANTUM DOT (R Oakford) – Raced wide throughout. Bumped and unbalanced near the 50m.

BEEDEEKAY (P Denton) – Impeded for clear running between the 200m and the 100m.

LEAN 'N' MEAN (K Cross) – Rider was reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding for allowing her mount to shift outwards over the final 100m causing interference near the 50m.

CAVALLINO RAMPANTE (S Ridler) – Rider dropped his whip near the 200m. Bumped at the 50m.

Race 4: 0 – 58 Handicap 1100 metres

BLUE SHORE (D Pisani) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 5: 0 – 64 Handicap 1600m

MAN CAVE (P Denton) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start.

LITTLE AUDREY (K Cross) – Raced in restricted room passing the 500m.

OUR ORACLE (D Pisani) – Commenced awkwardly.

ALL KNOWN (B Huppatz) – Crowded at the start.

Race 6: Katherine Cup 1600m

WARREGO MELODY (B Davis) – Crowded and steadied passing the 600m. Rider was reprimanded under AR137A(5)(ii) for using his whip in the forehand manner on 4 additional occasions than permitted prior to the 100m.

NEW EMPIRE (P Denton) – Commenced awkwardly.

DARLIMURLA STAR (B Huppatz) – Knuckled at the start.
