Race 1: Lasseters Benchmark Handicap 1400 metres

HOLLYWOOD AND VINE (S Rowley) – Steadied near the 1200m.

ANOTHER SNAPPY (K Connor) – Raced wide throughout. Rider reported that the gelding raced in a flat manner. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer Mr G Connor advised the gelding would now spell.

THREELEGSAGAIN (A Doyle) – Slow to begin.

Race 2: UNIBET Class B Handicap 1400 metres

ESTAMBUL THIRTEEN (S Rowley) – When questioned rider advised that after electing to take her mount wide rounding the home turn, the gelding then had a tendency to hang inwards over the final 300m.

BIG EGO ROCK (A Doyle) – Slow into stride.

Race 3: Wally Huntly Memorial 0 - 70 Handicap 1200 metres

NOIR RASOIR (S Rowley) – Knuckled at the start.

NEW EMPIRE (W Kerford) – Slow into stride. Ease over the final stages when tightened between runners.

Race 4: XXXX Gold 0 - 58 Handicap 1100 metres

CAPACITATE (K Connor) – Commenced awkwardly. Had a tendency to lay in over the concluding stages. Returned having bled from the off side nostril. Trainer Mr G Connor was advised of his obligations under AR 53A(7).

DISCOVERY LAD (W Kerford) – Dipped after jumping.

VICTORIOUS TALE (J Cameron) – Ease approaching the 600m.

FERICELLE (A Doyle) – Slow into stride.

Race 5: NT TROBIS 3YO Benchmark Handicap 1000 metres

PURRFECT PARAGON (K Gladwin) – Dwelt and then bumped at the start, bumped.

GANNICUS (J Cameron) – Commenced awkwardly and bumped.

IMPERIAL DYNASTY (W Kerford) – Slow into stride.

Post-race samples were taken from all winners.

Embargos – CAPACITATE – G Connor. A.R.53(7) bled from the off side nostril and is required to gallop over 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to racing again.
