As C Moon was indisposed through illness, Stewards took the following action in relation to his riding engagements:

Race 2 REDOUTE'S EMPIRE late scratching at 12:44 as there was no other rider available.

Race 5 SHIVORO was ridden by D Pisani (1/2kg overweight)

Race 1 Go Green Irrigation Handicap 1200 metres

STEINBERG (K Gladwin) – Despite the efforts of its rider, failed to maintain a competitive position throughout the event. A post-race examination revealed the gelding to be slow to recover.

DANCING POETESS (F Bergstrand) – Commenced awkwardly.

Race 2: Central Australian Removals Maiden Plate 1200 metres

I WANT CANDY (R Vigar) – Knuckled shortly after jumping.

MEROONI (B Davis) – Bumped with another runner at the 100m.

RUPERT (S Westover) – Bumped with another runner at the 250m.

CANDLESTICKS (K Manoukian) – Jumped outwards bumping with another runner. Shifted out at the 100m bumping with another runner.

MISS ALLIE (D Pisani) – Shifted out slightly at the 250m bumping with another runner.

WILANDER DIAMOND (F Bergstrand) – Crowded for room shortly after jumping.

BONUSES (B Huppatz) – Bumped with another runner at the 100m.

TORCHLIGHT (J Cameron) – Crowded for room on jumping.

Race 3: SDA Plumbing Handicap 1100 metres

STAR OF HARKAWAY (S Westover) – Rider fined \$100 for breach of AR137A(5)(a)(i) for using his whip in the forehand manner on one consecutive manner prior to the 100m.

REMEMBER RAZOR (R Vigar) – Steadied off heels about the 700m.

BLONDE JOURNEY (F Bergstrand) – Raced greenly throughout the event. Rider reported that the mare felt amiss in its action at the end of the race. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the mare had swelling to the off for leg around the mid cannon and a suspected tendon injury. Trainer Mr K Lamprecht was advised that he must present a veterinary certificate of

soundness for the mare prior to starting in a trial or race. Mr Lamprecht was further advised to keep the Stewards updated as to its progress regarding the suspected tendon injury.

Race 4: Melbourne Cup Luncheon Handicap 1000 metres

ARTIE'S REWARD (K Gladwin) – Slow into stride.

PAZZIMY (J Cameron) – Inclined to over-race in the early stages of the event.

Race 5: Wally Huntly Memorial Handicap 1400 metres

QUANTUM DOT (K Gladwin) – Bumped with another runner on jumping.

DOUBLE FIVE (B Davis) – Bumped with another runner on jumping.

RANDI (F Bergstrand) – As the start was effected, reared and lost some ground.

SLIPPER DREAM (R Vigar) – Bumped with another runner on jumping. Rider fined \$200 for a breach of AR137A(4)(b) in the he used his whip in an action that raises his arm above shoulder height.

THE NIGHT SKY (W Kerford) – Momentarily held up for a clear run approaching the 400m.

SHIVORO (D Pisani) – As D Pisani was a late rider replacement, Stewards permitted him to ride ½ kg over the allotted weight.

General: Stewards have adjourned an inquiry to a time and date to be fixed into C Moon being unable to fulfil his riding engagements.
