RACE 1 0-64 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, HOLLYWOOD AND VINE (R Vigar) was slow into stride. Shortly after the start, KING CRUSADER (J Cameron) shifted across to the fence and in doing so, ONTHEHUSSLE (L Stojakovic) on its inside was taken in slightly onto STRIKE ALERT (P Crich) which got its head up when being restrained and shortly after STRIKE ALERT had to steady off the heels of ONTHEHUSSLE after it shifted out. J Cameron rider of KING CRUSADER was issued with a severe reprimand for not being sufficiently clear of other runners when allowing her mount to shift ground. SKYSTAR (M Hart) was inclined to lay in under pressure down the length of the straight.

RACE 2 0-58 HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, MYSTIC OBSESSION (R Vigar) jumped awkwardly bumping STORMY REBEL (K Connor) on its outside. LOVE AFFAIR (P Denton) raced wide in the early stages of the event.

RACE 3 3YO BENCHMARK 53 1000 METRE:

As the gates opened, NEVER SATISFIED (M Hart) jumped awkwardly and commenced to race greenly in the early stages of the event. LEAVE A MESSAGE (K Connor) rolled in over the concluding stages of the event bumping with A BEST A MAN CAN GET (C Moon) racing along the rails.

RACE 4 CLASS B HANDICAP 1400 METRES:

Shortly after jumping, FOOT ON THE TILL (J Cameron) failed to muster early speed and began to loose ground.

About the 1000m, TURBO BOY (R Vigar) began to roll in making contact with SHOOT N SCOOT (N Paine) and in doing so momentarily inconvenienced that gelding for room along the rails.

Correct weight for this event was delayed when N Paine rider of the second place-getter requested to view the stewards patrol footage of the back straight with a view of protesting.

After viewing the footage, correct weight was declared.

R Vigar rider of TURBO BOY was advised by stewards that he must be mindful of riders on his inside and give them the room to which they are entitled to.

As the gates opened, LUCERNE VALE (J Cameron) dipped slightly.
