Race 1: 28TH November Young Guns 2 Handicap 1200 metres

EXTRACEED (D Pisani) – Bumped at the 100m.

KING CRUSADER (C Moon) – Raced wide throughout. Bumped another runner near the 100m.

ARTIE'S REWARD (R Vigar) – Commenced awkwardly.

Race 2: Colemans Printing Plate 1200 metres

GOLDEN TONE (F Bergstrand) – Impeded when under pressure near the 100m.

NEVER POINTLESS (S Westover) – Commenced awkwardly and crowded shortly after the start.

HEART OF RED (T Gillett) – A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

FLYING FAY (D Pisani) – Lay outwards when racing greenly in the back straight and as a result was restrained from heels losing ground at the 800m.

CLOCKIMUS PRIME (R Vigar) – Raced greenly in running and wide for the majority of the event.

General: Jockey T Gillett (HEART OF RED) was reprimanded for careless riding under AR137(a) for allowing his mount to shift ground inwards uncorrected in the straight resulting in GOLDEN TONE (F Bergstrand) being hampered near the 100m.

Race 3: XXXX Gold Handicap 1000 metres

STAR OF HARKAWAY (S Westover) – Rider advised the mare raced in a flat manner and trainer Mrs L Gillett advised the mare would now be sent for a spell.

Race 4: First National Framptons Handicap 1400 metres

GALA ARCH (B Huppatz) – Had to steady of heels at the 900m.

THE HIGHT SKY (B Davis) Rider reported his saddle shifted at the start and placed him at a disadvantage in running.

Race 5: Arthur J Gallagher Handicap 1400 metres

GARRETT COUNTY (F Bergstrand) – Rolled outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

SHOGUN'S REIGN (K Gladwin) – Raced wide from the 600m. Lay inwards under pressure over the final 100m.

YES MA'AM (J Cameron) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in both front legs. Trainer Mr M Nyhan was advised that he must present a veterinary certificate of soundness for the mare prior to racing again.

SHIVORO (B Huppatz) – When questioned regarding his tactics rider advised that after obtaining a position with cover the pace slackened mid race and his mount then commenced to race keenly and he elected to shift out to a 3 deep position and the gelding finished the race off strongly in the straight.

Fines/Suspensions/embargos

Race 2 – Jockey T Gillett (HEART OF RED) was fined \$100 for using his whip in the forehand manner on 1 additional occasion than permitted prior to the 100m – AR137A(5)(a)(ii)

Race 2 – Jockey T Gillett was reprimanded for careless riding - AR137(a)

Race 5 - YES MA'AM Veterinary certificate
