RACE 2 0-58 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, GET CLOSER (B Hoppo) was slow into stride whilst IMA GODDESS (J Cameron) jumped awkwardly brushing WINDJANA GORGE (S Evans) on its inside.

Approaching the first turn, MISS PARKER (C Johnson) bumped with SPINNING APPLE (R Vigar) on its inside.

RACE 3 0-64 HANDICAP 1100 METRE:

BRIEF BUZZ (R Vigar) was fractious in the barriers.

On jumping, ZILCH (B Hoppo) was tightened momentarily between runners.

ZILCH was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn causing its rider some difficulties.

RACE 4 CLASS B HANDICAP 1400 METRES:

BILLYESS was a late scratching at 3:30 on Veterinary advice after an inspection was carried out in its stable in regards to a suspected shoe nail prick to its near/side front. The Veterinary surgeon also advised the stewards that as the injury was minor, no further treatment or inspections would be required.

As betting had not commenced on this event there were no deductions to be made.

As the gates opened, ZIPALANG (S Evans) which jumped a little awkwardly bumped with MIDNIGHT GIGGLE (C Moon) on its inside.

Shortly after jumping INDEE'S HOPE (K Connor) rolled out bumping RANDI (B Huppatz) on its outside.

Rounding the first turn, RANDI attempted to run off the track and as a consequence CHURCHI (R Vigar) on its outside was taken out wide and ZIPALANG also on its outside and one back, had to be severely checked when tightened for room onto CHURCHI.

Mr Lamprecht the trainer of RANDI was advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to it again racing.

Mr R Bell the trainer of GODLIKE advised the stewards that the gelding had pulled up short in its action.

Stewards advised Mr Bell that a Veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to GODLIKE again starting in a race.
