RACE 1 0-64 HANDICAP 1200 METRES:

As the gates opened, ALL RILED UP (K Connor) was momentarily tightened for room between runners.

CULLENARY DELIGHT (P Crich) raced wide throughout the event.

Subsequent to this event, P Crich was questioned by stewards in regards to his lack of endeavour on his mount (CULLENARY DELIGHT) down the length of the straight.

P Crich advised that whilst the mare was laying in slightly, he does not use the whip much on her as she resents it.

Whilst stewards accepted P Crich's explanation, he was advised that in similar circumstances he must be seen to push his mounts out with more vigour hands and heels, especially when his mounts are running home strong.

RACE 2 0-70 HANDICAP 1100 METRES:

As the gates opened, SUNDAY PSALM (R Vigar) knuckled slightly whilst LAYNE (P Denton) was a little slow into stride.

Subsequent to this event R Vigar was found guilty of a charge under AR87B(1) in that he was found to be wearing a safety vest which was in the opinion of the stewards in poor condition and did not have the manufacturer's label attached that states that it complies with the relevant standard prescribed by the Board.

R Vigar was fined the sum of \$200 and notified of his right of appeal.

All monies invested on MONEYBALL withdrawn by the stewards on veterinary advice at 4:31 to be refunded.

Trainer of MONEYBALL, Mrs L Lefoe was advised that prior to that gelding again starting in a race, she must produce a veterinary certificate of soundness satisfactory to the stewards.
