Race 2 – 0-70 HCP - 1100 metres:

The Clubs Veterinary Surgeon inspected MAJOR NELSON which had injured en route to the race meeting and advised the stewards that the gelding was not fit to start.

Acting on this advice stewards ordered the withdrawal of MAJOR NELSON at 1.21pm.

On jumping away DISPLAY dipped slightly.

1st LUCERNE VALE 2nd THUMB PRINTS 3rd DISPLAY

Race 3 – 0-64 HCP - 1600 metres:

On jumping away ALANAS MATE shifted out slightly and tightened THE CAT which overreacted and got its head up.

Racing to the first turn THE CAT got its head up and raced ungenerously and went wide as a consequence.

Race 4 – 0 – 58 HCP - 1000 metres:

Prior to the correct weight being declared K Jennings rider of RIBATI requested to view the head on vision of the start.

When the gates opened WALTER JOHN got it's head up and was slow to begin.

On jumping away RIBATI was struck by the front gate which bounced back after opening.

Shortly after the start UPHEBOBS jumped inwards onto EXPLOSIVE KISS forcing that gelding to make contact with RIBATI.
